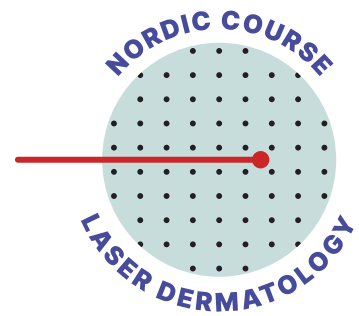


Welcome to the Nordic Course on Laser Dermatology
